In accordance with the above it is hereby announced that the 1973 IMCCSRA National Championship Regatta will be conducted at the Shreveport Yacht Club, Shreveport, Louisiana, October 5, 6 and 7, 1973.

A Regatta Chairman will be appointed shortly and more detail scheduling will be forwarded as soon as possible.

As of May 19, 1973, the following results have been tabulated concerning the location and dates for the 1973 IMCCSRA National Championship Races:


Location: Shreveport, Louisiana	20 votes

October 19, 20, 21


with the preference for the latter. The Club facilities and race committees will be available for these weekends.
