Winter-weary Sailors Flock to Atlanta

Bright sunshine and temperatures in the high 70s rewarded MC sailors who traveled from Colorado, Ohio, Michigan, Wisconsin, Florida, Texas, and North Carolina for the 1995 Rebel Rouser/Southeastern Championship at Lake Lanier. A total of 29 MC skippers vied for the regional title.

Because most people traveling to the regatta usually arrive sometime on Friday, we decided to offer a full afternoon and evening of activities on that day. In fact, three practice races were sailed Friday in perfect conditions. That evening everyone enjoyed a free cookout and a seminar conducted by Andy Burdick and Greg Fisher. The focal points for the seminar were two brand new boats (one Melges and one Johnson) set up on trailers right at the clubhouse. Greg concentrated on the fine points of sail adjustment and trim using a new North "Big Boy" set on the Johnson boat. Andy dealt predominately with rig tension and boat handling. Andy even explained in detail how he tacks -- where he plants his feet, where and when he moves his body, and how he exchanges the tiller and the sheet from one hand to the other.

For the first race on Saturday morning, winds were 8-10 and very shifty. Tim Fredman won and then placed second in Saturday afternoon's shortened race. Andy Burdick placed third and first to finish the day in second behind Fredman. On Sunday morning Lake Lanier was glassy calm, but after a short wait, a relatively stead 8-12 mph wind appeared which allowed two more races before lunch time. Andy Burdick won both. Scott Slocum and Greg Fisher dueled for second place and ended the series in a tie. Slocum's second place finish in Saturday's first race put him ahead of Fisher whose best finish was third.

Fleet 3 would especially like to thank North, Melges, and Johnson for providing favors and door prizes. North provided T-shirts for every skipper as well as several door prizes. Melges and Johnson also provided door prizes which made for a lively give-away session after Saturday night's steak dinner.

One of the more unique aspects of this year's regatta was something new called "secret teams." Sailors were randomly paired, and then the total scores of the pairs were tabulated. The lowest team score won. What made it interesting was that no one knew the identity of their teammate, until trophy presentation. Throughout the regatta you always had to wonder if the skipper you just tacked on and gassed might actually be your partner. Everyone thought it was great fun and the winning team turned out to be Scott Slocum and Knox Rogers.

We are pleased that so many sailors like to come to Lake Lanier in April. Believe it or not, we have already begun planning for next year. We anticipate a mid- to late-April date. We will again plan to have activities on Friday, and most importantly, we are planning perfect weather. See you in Atlanta in '96.
