

THE 14TH ANNUAL MC NATIONAL REGATTA & ANNUAL MEETING - went off in true Texas style! Great hospitality and greater winds prevailed. Many thanks go to Dave & Betsy Greene and their committees of Fleet 5 for hosting this fine event. Al Finster and his race committee did a very professional job with the œurses, rescue boats, etc., in winds which ranged from 12-20 before calming down to the 5-10 range Sunday. Most all skippers sailed with a crew; even so quite a few opted to take a DNF or DNS to rest up. (And watch a football game!)

Trophies were awarded to the top 10 in the regular fleet. Gary Verplank of Spring Lake, Mi. Fleet #7 with Vicki Verplank crewing, took first honors with 2-1-1-6-1 finishes, 10-3/4 points ahead of 2nd place skipper, Jimmy Gluek of Excelsior, Mn., 21 points, followed by Bob Cummings of Dallas, Dick Prokup of Dallas, Dan Quiram of Davenport, Ia., Carl Reuterdahl of Spring Lake, Mick Sage of Stratford, Tx., Mike Huck of Lake Geneva, Wi., Bob Kwasha of Atlanta and Happy Fox of Grand Rapids, Mi. The complete regatta results are attached.

The "Masters Fleet", newly established for both the Nationals and Midwinters, now has a handsome new trophy for 1st place. Thanks go to Dave & Betsy Greene of Dallas Fleet 5 for this donation; additional trophies are planned for the "Masters" - skippers 50 and over as of January 1st of the regatta year. In this group, finishes were Bill Freytag, Fontana, Wi., John Maloney of Ft. Collins, Co., Tony Bruskas of Matherville, Il, Eldon Irving of Duncanville, Tx., and Dave Greene of Dallas in the 1st five spots. In addition to the Greene trophy, first overall of the Masters, Bill Freytag also took the new George Dorn Memorial Trophy as first in the first race. Special thanks go to members of Davenport, Ia. Fleet 20 for the Dorn trophy, beautifully crafted by two fleet members.

The Annual Meeting was short. Commodore Mike Fieseler noted the additions of Fleets 25, in Omaha, and 26 at Pistakee YC, Fox Lake, McHenry, II. A new charter request was received for Fleet 27, "The Front Range MC Fleet", headquartered in Sterling Colorado, sailing on Lake McConaughy near Ogalalla, Ne., and regatta participants Roger & Bobbie Sage, Mick Sage, John & Gail Maloney were welcomed. Initially Fleet 27 has 8 boats with more anticipated. Happy Fox and Carl Reuterdahl have asked to reserve rights to establish a Blue Chip MC regatta program at Grand Rapids, Mi. The Board has approved IMCCSRA making application for membership in the Inland Yacht Racing Ass'n. The proposed revised By-laws Article IX, "Specifications of the Yacht," were discussed; it is planned to submit these to the fleets with comments to be returned by 12-1-84, and final presentation about the time of the '85 Midwinter Regatta. An invitation has been accepted to hold the '85 National Regatta on Lake Geneva, Wi., hosts to be E. Troy, Wi. Fleet #15 and Lake Geneva YC where an MC fleet may be established. New Board members were elected to terms starting 1-1-85: Happy Fox, Roger Sage, Bob Kwasha and Tony Bruskas. Mike Fieseler will serve another year as Commodore. On the Technical Committee, Dave Greene will serve as replacement for George Dorn.
